Dear Pinecrest Family,

As I preached on Daniel 6 just a few weeks ago, Daniel in the Lion's Den, I realized that many of us may be more sympathetic to Daniel's plight after the past two months. Many of us may feel like we are in a lion's den right now. We feel as if we've been imprisoned like Daniel was, just in our houses—not in a lion's den.
