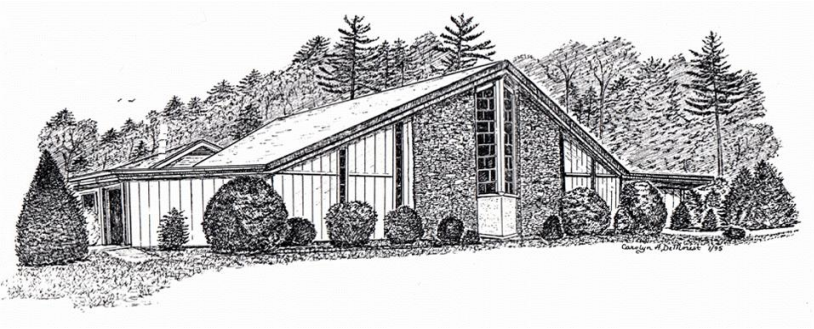

- I. People of all ages prefer purpose.
 - A. Christians need a sense of purpose in worship.
 1. Observations
 - a. It is good to worship in God’s house.
 - b. Worship gives opportunity to give testimony to our faith and to pray.
 - c. Worship gives unity to fellowship and to prayer.
 - d. Worship stimulates spiritual growth.
 - e. Worship affords a Christian witness to unsaved people.
 - f. Worship gives preview of heaven.
 - B. Worship can lack purpose.
 1. If offered out of habit
 2. If the sermon is the sole object of our interest
 3. If we seek only to be cheered and entertained
 - C. What Christians should do in worship - which make worship purposeful.
 1. Confess sin.
 2. Ask for mercy.
 3. Give offerings.
 4. Praise God in Jesus Christ
