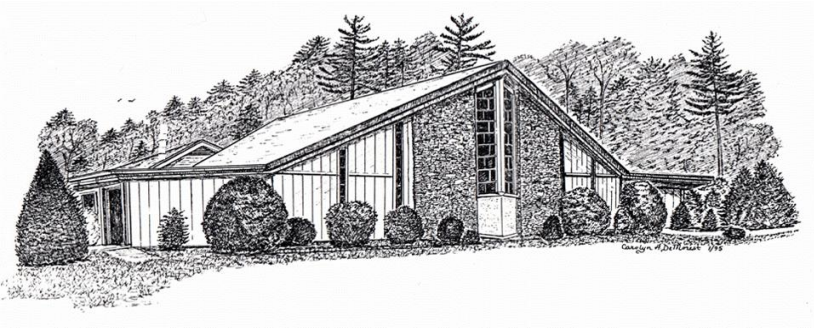

- I. Our purpose is to look at the relevance of Christian worship.
 - A. A definition of relevance - “up-to-date, current, and vital”
 - B. Our text: **“The twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshipped God, who was seated on the throne. And they cried: ‘Amen, Hallelujah!’” (Revelation 19:4)**
- II. This text gives us four aspects of relevant worship.
 - A. Acceptance of God’s will - “Amen” - so be it
 - B. Commitment to the purposes of God - “Amen - Your will be done”
 - C. Joy in the fellowship of God - “Hallalujah!”
 - D. Assurance of Spiritual victory
