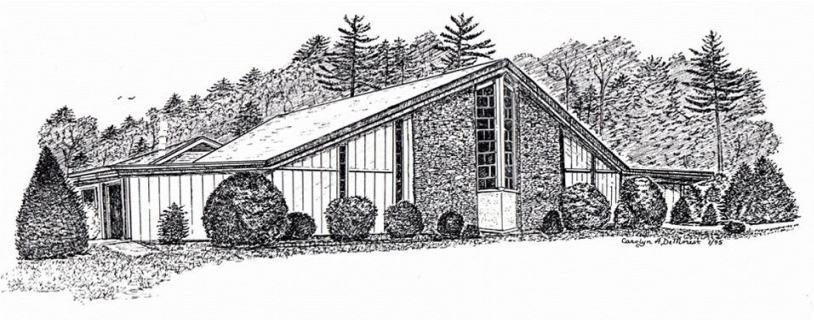

- I. Illustration: “If one of us would get off, there would be room for me.”
 - A. Selfishness is a real and pervasive problem.
 - B. Uncontrolled selfishness can be dangerous.
 - C. Selfish people can be gracious in their community and terrors at home.
- II. Jesus presents three demands.
 - A. Deny self
 - B. Take up a cross
 - C. Follow Him
- III. Our Lord’s reasoning - to save our life and our self, we must lose them.
 - A. Jesus draws on the Final Judgment as encouragement for dealing with selfishness.
 - B. Self is the issue often in our relationship with Christ and with our fellowman.
 - C. As we are sold out to Christ, self will be moderated and controlled.
