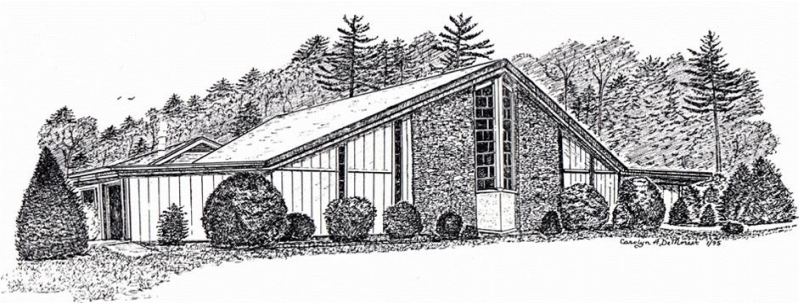

- I. Text gives formula for Christian usefulness - four directives
 - A. We cannot handle life alone.
 - B. We must acknowledge God’s involvement in every detail of life.
 - C. We must know that God is interested in each of us.
 - D. We must trust God in everything.
- II. Christian usefulness makes demands and offers rewards.
 - A. It requires that we know and obey God’s commands. — Proverbs 3:1-2
 - B. It requires love and faithfulness to God and to our fellowman. - Proverbs 3:3-4
 - C. It requires dependence on God rather than man. Proverbs 3:7-8
 - D. It requires generosity. - Proverbs 3:9-10
 - E. It requires acceptance of God’s rebuke and discipline. - Proverbs 3:11-12
